Introductory Elective Gun Safety Course for CAS Middle School

This introductory elective course on Gun Safety is focused on selected **8th grade** students and their parents who have an interest in promoting gun safety along with an introduction to the Arizona Game and Fish Departments Hunter Education Program.

The course content has been drawn from the Arizona Gun Safety Program (Arizona Revised Statute 15-714.01) and educational materials from the National Sport Shooting Foundation and instructional materials from the National Rifle Association.

--Instruction on the rules of gun safety.

--Instruction on the basic operation of firearms.

--Instruction on the history of firearms and marksmanship.

--An overview on the several types of competitive sport shooting events.

Instruction will be conducted by a NRA-certified firearms instructor as approved by the Arizona Game and Fish Department. Instruction will be supplemented by the use of audio-visual training aides.

Above all else, SAFETY will be the byword of all activities. Self-discipline, attention to detail and teamwork are fundamental requirements of all student participants.

History, Arizona and U.S. Government and English components of instruction are interwoven into the classroom instruction. Students will research, compose papers and produce PowerPoint presentations and develop team projects where appropriate.
