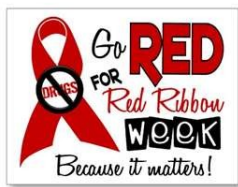

TRAFFIC CONTROL

*As explained in our Student-Parent Handbook 2011, Page 13, Para. 1, **Transportation and Parking** has been a big concern with our CAS Safety Team. We have set the campus up with traffic indicators to ensure a smooth drop-off and pick-up*

*routine for parents and faculty. Red curbs indicate a Fire Lane (DO NOT leave vehicles unattended), U-Turns are prohibited **AT ALL TIMES**, park in the designated areas we have assigned for our CAS Guests, DO NOT park within 30 feet of*
