

## Child Find

The Center for Academic Success, Inc., provides special education services to eligible students ages five through 21 years of age. Children ages birth through five—who are suspected to have a developmental disability--will be referred to the Arizona Early Intervention Program (AzEIP) and/or their local school district. This insures a disabled child can be provided a free appropriate public education (FAPE) through a continuum of services. All referrals are considered confidential, and appropriate services are provided at no cost. The parent, legal guardian, or surrogate parent retains the right to refuse services and is provided other procedural safeguards under federal and state law.

The Individuals with Disabilities Education Improvement Act (IDEA) requires a free appropriate public education with a full continuum of services be available for eligible children with disabilities.
